Do you fancy working at one of the country's leading equestrian centres, awarded Best Centre 2023 Your role is to be an integral part of our team delivering and maintaining excellent outdoor and indoor facilities for the equestrian community and farm activities. We run events on a regular basis from grass roots to international eventing, showjumping and dressage. There is also a growing number of new clients for dog shows, and alternative equine disciplines.

The event role varies enormously depending on the event calendar and will include maintaining our farm ride, gallop, cross country schooling field, 2 indoor and 2 outdoor arenas and stables. This will involve moving show jumps, setting up dressage, moving cross country fences, painting, harrowing arenas, delivering haylage and shavings, building fences, knocking in and removing jump anchors, erecting sponsors banners, mowing grass, strimming and stringing courses. On the farm side we've 500 acres to look after. We have 120 youngstock grazing and make 200 acres or so haylage. The role offers tremendous variation and job satisfaction.

Typical hours are 7am - 5pm, with an hour for lunch. Extra time will sometimes be required depending on the event and farm diary.

You will need to work 1 weekend in 3 on the Saturday and Sunday, normal hours.

Knowledge of tractor driving and JCB materials handlers would be an advantage. You must be keen to work to a high standard with a keen eye on attention to detail. You must be willing to work on your own or as part of team. You don't need any equestrian knowledge or riding experience. You will need to be polite and keen to give great customer service.
